### 2. Time schedule

- Session 1 of Saturday: start time = 13h30
  
- Officials Meeting on Sunday @ 9h00
- Session 2 of Sunday: start time = 10h00

### 3. Entries

We have received entries of swimmers with entry times slower than the considered entry time. We have accepted all swimmers as the overall number of entries and the time schedule allow us this year to accept everybody.

### 4. Withdrawal deadlines for absent swimmers are as follows:

The start list for Saturday will be available on [www.scde.lu](http://www.scde.lu) by 19h00 so that you can print it before coming to the competition on Saturday.
- For Session 2 = latest by Saturday 17h00 via email or at the referee table. The start list will be available on [www.scde.lu](http://www.scde.lu) but we will have also copies of the start lists available for the teams staying overnight in Ettelbruck.
- Withdrawals from Finals: Any finalist or reserve for a final who does not wish to swim in a Final must complete a withdrawal form and submit it to the referee table at the latest 30 minutes after the results of the preliminary heats of the event are published. Failure to comply with this procedure will result in a fine of € 50.

### 5. Start lists, results and livestream

### 6. Medal ceremonies: all medal ceremonies will take place after the end of session 1 and session 3 in the Cafeteria. A detailed timeline for the ceremonies for Saturday and Sunday will be shared with all teams in due time. Please ensure



that your swimmers are ready in the cafeteria at the scheduled time. The victory ceremonies are part of the competition. Medals and prizes are not handed out if the swimmer is not present at the ceremony.

**7. Swimming Pool, Parking and smoking**

There is free parking in front of the swimming pool but is strictly forbidden to use the parking spots reserved for the 'Direction' of the Lycée.

Also, as per law it is strictly forbidden to smoke outside of the pool between the building of the sport complex and the cafeteria as well as on the entire parking. People who wish to smoke will need to leave the complex and the parking of the school and go to the public street. Thank you for your understanding and respecting this rule!

**8. Athletes seating and pool access**

Athletes will be seated in the sports hall next to the swimming pool. Please do not forget to bring your own chairs and depending on the weather, warm clothes as it might be cold in the sports hall. Swimmers and coaches will not be allowed to take any bags into the swimming pool.

The call room is located in the women's changing room. A TV screen with livestream will be installed in the call room and there is direct access to toilets in the call room.

To watch swimming, athletes and coaches can access the pool deck exclusively through the men's changing room. After their races swimmers will leave the pool deck along the window side to go back to the sports hall. Changing rooms and showers for athletes are available next to the sports hall.
